The proposal for a “K-L couplet” would shift the southbound traffic now on K Street over to a new through-road in the L Street Corridor, from Alliance Road to Samoa Boulevard. Cars, motorcycles, delivery trucks, and even semi-trucks would be rolling and thundering past the pathway / bikepath – **just 6 feet away.**

The L Street Pathway is a quiet oasis in the heart of the Creamery District and a great nature walk to the marsh. It can continue to be people-oriented and not car-centric, as the City has planned. **If you agree, please speak up.**
